

August 6, 2020 – work session

The work session for the month of August began at 6:50 p.m., with the Pledge of Allegiance and was presided over by President Cebulskie. Those answering to roll call were: Cebulskie, McMillen, Burkett and Scolese.

An invitation for a party to thank the Borough for everything they have done in assisting with the Pool was read. The party will be August 14, 2020, from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.

At this time Burkett informed the Council that he and Scolese met with members of the County, as well as Toby Fauver, regarding the Multi-Modul grant. It was mentioned that the meeting was based upon applying for new sidewalks, street post lighting, raised crosswalks, and bulb outs on Main Street, between Third and Fifth Streets.

Motion by McMillen seconded by Scolese to approve the application of said grant.

Cebulskie stated that he has been in contact with Derek Wolfanger, regarding a Forensic Audit of the Water/Sewer Authority records. He went on to say that this was as per the last Council meeting where it was discussed to proceed with having Wolfanger complete the evaluation; however, Atty. Ryan informed Cebulskie that no motion was formally made. At this time Cebulskie requested a motion, as per the previous executive session to approve said evaluation. Hearing no motion for this to be done, this audit will not be completed at this time.

A discussion was held relative to the upstairs store room. Dixon advised that there is too much overflow of different offices being put in this area. The Council stated that partitioning rooms off inside the social room would be a suggestion. This matter will be looked in to further.

At this time an Executive Session was called for the purpose of discussing personnel matters- 7:14 p.m.

The Executive Session was reconvened at 8:00 p.m.
