It was discussed about the need for additional part time police assistance. No formal action was taken at this time.

After a lengthy review of the 2020 budget, a motion was made by Scolese and seconded by Popson to approve the advertising of the 2020 budget, as well as the Occupational Assessment Tax and Real Estate millage Ordinances, for passage at February's meeting. Question on motion.
